PROCLAMATION

HOME AND SCHOOL VISITOR/SCHOOL SOCIAL WORKER WEEK March 8-12, 2021

WHEREAS, Home and School Visitors/School Social Workers have shown since 1906 that they are dedicated to improving the relationship between school and home to facilitate students' educational experiences in our complex society.
